**Ken Newman's** *Well Worn* won the Founders Award at the "25th Anniversary Wallowa Art Festival" in Joseph, Oregon. It was also included in the "Lines into Shapes" exhibition (Estes Park, Colorado); "Bold Expressions" (Sacramento, California); and "Allied Artists Exhibition" (New York City). His bronze, *Precipitous Drop*, was chosen for the Society of Animal Artist's "Art and The Animal" exhibition and was featured as Editor's Choice in the July/August edition of *Wildlife Art*.

**Lubomir Tomaszewski** organized a group show for his "Emotionalist" art movement. Nearly two dozen artists participated in the November 4 - 15 exhibition at the Orange County SUNY Hall in Middletown, New York.
